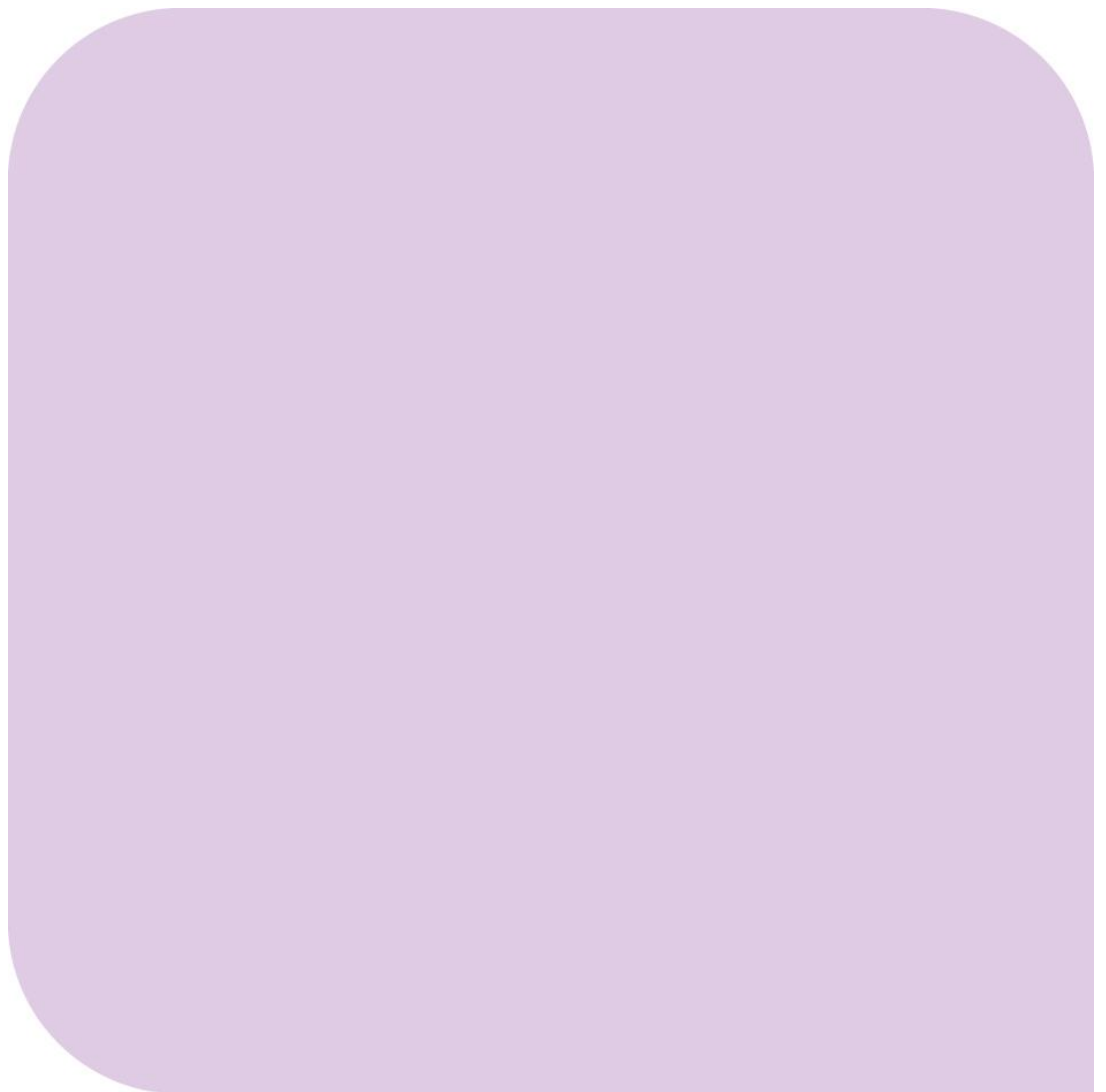


Social Care Online: Topic tree (hierarchical)
